
# THE PROVE IT POST

The name "America" was first recorded on a map made by the German cartographer Martin Waldseemüller in France in the year of our Lord 1,507 placed in south America. 


South America on Martin Waldseemüller's world map

His map did not reach Spain until after Amerigo Vespucci's death. So the name may have came from the Amerrisque Mountains in Nicaragua where Christopher Columbus landed on his 4<sup>th</sup> voyage. Amerrisque means "country of the Wind" so it may have changed to America and then spread by spoken language throughout Europe relatively quickly even reaching Martin Waldseemüller. Either way


